

Exhibit/Floral Hall Open Class Rules

Open Classes in the Exhibit Hall are open to the public at no charge.

Exhibitors shall make entries on Tuesday, September 1, 2026, between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM. Exhibitors must pick up items, ribbons and prize money on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, between 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM. All articles must remain in the hall until Tuesday at the time of pick up. If exhibits are not claimed, they will be discarded.

At the time of entry, persons exhibiting items in the hall shall select the category, subcategory, and class in which they will show. Ex: Category 1 - Fruit, Subcategory A - Apples, Class 1 - Red Delicious

Categories are 1 through 11, Letters are subcategories and numbers are the class. See example above.

Each exhibitor will be restricted to entering two entries in any one class except where noted.

All judging will be on Wednesday, September 2, 2026.

The ownership of the items in the hall shall be withheld from the judges. No person, except the judges and officers, will be allowed to remain in the hall while the judges are awarding the premiums.

Premiums will be paid by cash.

Special care will be taken of items exhibited, but the Campbell County Agricultural Society shall not be held responsible for any items that may be lost, damaged or stolen. We cannot display items behind locked doors.

All articles, which are the product of the soil, must be entered in the name of the producer of the same, and no person shall exhibit fruit, flowers, other products, other than those of his or her own raising or his or her representative.

All food exhibits must be cleaned of soil and in edible condition.

No entry can be shown that has been a former first place winner in the Exhibit Hall of the Alexandria Fair and Horse Show.

Unless otherwise noted, all items will be displayed in Fair-provided containers.

Except where noted all Exhibit Hall premiums will be - 1st Place \$4, 2nd Place \$3, 3rd Place \$2.
